Breakdown of Titrations

• We would recommend revising the acid and base chapter before studying these notes.

There are 3 types of titrations that can come up:

- 1. Acid-Base
- 2. Redox
- 3. Water

There are 8 different titrations that they can ask:

Acid-Base

- 1. Sodium Carbonate vs. HCl
- 2. Percentage of water of crystallisation in washing soda
- 3. Find the percentage of ethanoic acid in vinegar

Redox (Potassium Manganate KMnO₄ vs iron) 1. To find the percentage of iron in an iron tablet

Redox (lodine vs Thiosulfate)

- 1. Iodine vs Thiosulfate
- 2. The amount of hypochlorite in bleach

Water

- 1. The hardness of water in a sample.
- 2. The amount of dissolved oxygen in water (this is also an iodine vs. thiosulfate titratin)
